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Frequently Asked Questions

Is this a paid internship?

Interns will receive a small stipend upon completion of the program. Research Interns receive \$300, Explorer Interns receive \$100. Lunch and parking passes will be provided for Explorer Interns.

Is there a primary focus area for interns?

Interns will work with and learn from researchers and scientists in a variety of fields. These may include: Soil & Crop Science, Plant Genetics, Biofuels, Biotechnology, Engineering, Bioengineering, Molecular Biology, Agriculture Economics and Science Education.

Will I be working in a lab?

Research Interns may work in a lab. Explorer Interns will spend time in labs but will not exclusively be a lab setting.

Are these programs in person or virtual?

All 2022 Internship opportunities are in person. All Interns will follow University of Arizona Covid guidelines. If you have questions, please check our website: covid19.arizona.edu

Do I have to have taken chemistry to apply? What if I took Biotechnology (MCB 101/102)?

Chemistry is a requirement (high school or college) but we will consider applicants who have taken biotechnology before chemistry. We prefer applicants have completed an in-depth research project.

Do I need a recommendation to apply?

Yes, all applicants need to provide a letter of reference, preferably from a science teacher.

Can I apply to both internship opportunities?

Yes, students can apply to both programs but because programs overlap, students will only be selected for one.
